- Advocate for responsible, evidence-based transparency across Congress and the Executive Branch.
- Commission National Intelligence Estimate on UAP.
- Collaborate with key government agencies to meet records disclosure requirements.
- Develop policy on UAP and related emerging technologies.
- Provide legal and financial support for UAP whistleblowers.
- Educate the public through media engagements, campus events, commentary, symposia, and digital outreach.

WHAT WE'VE DONE

- Organized classified briefings for the House Oversight Committee's Task Force on the Declassification of Federal Secrets.
- Supplied Congress with UAP records and draft oversight letters focusing scrutiny on relevant national security agencies and classification authorities.
- Authored a legal brief clarifying congressional access rights to classified information and protections for whistleblowers.
- Hosted a congressional roundtable on UAP science, national security, and innovation.
- Convened a coalition of 40+ university scholars, former senior officials, and subject-matter experts calling for stronger transparency.
